I am delighted to announce that our school has joined the government's National School Breakfast Programme (NBSP), which is being delivered by the charities Family Action and Magic Breakfast. We want every child at Lyndhurst to start the day with everything they need in order to learn effectively; a fundamental element of this is a healthy, filling breakfast.

From **Monday 12th November**, children in Years 1 – 6, will be offered a **FREE bagel** in their classroom between **8.50am and 9.00am**. The bagels will be supplied by Magic Breakfast. This will give every child the opportunity to start the day with the right fuel for learning.

Below is a list of the ingredients, allergens and advisory information relating to the Magic Breakfast bagels. Please familiarise yourself with the information provided.

Ingredients for Magic Plain Bagel

Wheat flour, Water, **Wholemeal** flour, Sugar, Salt, Yeast and Malt

Allergens: Wheat flour (gluten), Wholemeal flour (gluten)

Advisory note: Made in a factory with uses milk products, contains wheat, gluten, yeast and sesame seeds.

BREAKTIME SNACKS

Nursery/Reception

Children in nursery and reception will be offered a bagel, fruit and milk mid morning each day, at no cost.

KS1

Snacks will be still be provided at morning break at a cost of 20p per day and will consist of fresh fruit or yoghurt. We will no longer provide toast at either break. All children in KS1 (Years 1 and 2) will continue to be offered a piece of fruit during afternoon break, at no cost.

KS2

Snacks will be still be provided at break at a cost of 20p per day and will consist of fresh fruit or yoghurt. We will no longer provide toast at break.

Breakfast club will continue to run as normal between 8.00am and 8.50am, at a cost of £2.50 per child, per day.

We look forward to seeing as many children as possible for breakfast.
